# DURING

### **SUPERVISION**

The PhD candidate and supervisor(s) evaluate the progress in an annual assessment interview.

#### **Tools for reflection**

The PhD competence <u>model</u>

External advice is given by the supervisory committee. Guidelines for this this discussion are <u>available</u>.

Of note, the <u>PhD course</u> <u>centre</u> offers courses on teaching and supervision skills for PhD supervisors.

#### SUPPORT AND CONFIDANTS

In case of problems, the first line of consultation are the supervisory committee and the coordinator of the PhD program (Erna van Wilsem).

In <u>addition</u>, confidants are present at your faculty or institution, as well as company counselors (UMC Utrecht) or staff welfare service (UU).
